

Meningococcal Disease Information – Each school district must provide the parents/guardians of students enrolled in grades 6 to 12 in the district with information about meningococcal disease, including: (a) the causes and symptoms of the disease, (b) how it is spread, and (c) how to obtain additional information about the disease and the availability, effectiveness and risks of vaccination against the disease.
